Harmony Roulette is your opportunity to experience quartet singing during the retreat. You will learn two songs (learning tracks provided) **prior to the weekend**.

On Saturday morning, you will enjoy singing in as many different quartet combinations as possible. In the afternoon, names will be drawn and your Harmony Roulette quartet will be born. After rehearsing, each quartet will sing for an adoring audience of Harmony Roulette peers!

What will we sing?

Good Old Acapella, Arranger: Chris Moyer

You Belong to Me, Arranger: June Berg

To order your sheet music, first login to SweetAdelines.com, then [CLICK HERE](#) to open the search page. Simply enter the song title in the appropriate box and then select SEARCH. Find the option with the specified arranger and "Add to Cart." When you opt to have the music shipped electronically, you will receive a PDF download. Learning tracks will be sent to you soon after your registration is complete.

Now it's time to start learning the songs. ***This event will only work if each singer is completely off paper and ready to sing each song***, so dig in and enjoy the harmony! The goal is to have the same number of singers for each voice part. If a section is full, you may get to try a different part! Register early to sing your first-choice part.

BASIC HARMONY ROULETTE EXPERIENCE SCHEDULE

Friday night: Attend classes with fellow Quartet Retreat participants. (7PM start)

Saturday: Attend the two Quartet Retreat classes and vocal warm-up period.

Session 1: Sing both songs as a group, work out any glitches, discover opportunities in the music.

Sessions 2-3: Individuals will aim to sing each song with every other singer. At the end of Session 3, there will be a random draw to assign quartets and to designate the song for each to sing.

Session 4: Quartets will rehearse their designated song, and prepare to perform in session 5.

Session 5: Quartets will sing for each other and choose the lucky quartet who will perform on Saturday evening. All participants will sing one song as a chorus on Saturday evening.

Saturday evening: The lucky quartet will perform their designated song. The remainder of Harmony Roulette singers will perform the other song as a chorus.
